

Course ① Kumamoto Castle & Suizenji Jojuen Park (about 5h)



You can see VR (virtual reality) videos of Kumamoto Castle in Edo period and some short plays. You can also enjoy ninja and kimono costing experience (some plans need extra fee).

The castle tower was reconstructed after 6 years of Kumamoto earthquake. You can overlook Kumamoto City from the top of the tower.

This is a traditional Japanese garden. You can enjoy tea at the special room (extra charge).



Course ② Kumamoto Castle, Suizenji Jojuen Park & more (about 7h)



You can see VR (virtual reality) videos of Kumamoto Castle in Edo period and some short plays. You can also enjoy ninja and kimono costing experience (some plans need extra fee).

There are many exhibitions about the history and nature of Kumamoto. You can also enjoy the planetarium (extra charge).

Kiyomasa Kato, the builder of Kumamoto Castle, is enshrined here. You can see Uto Turret and Main Tower of Kumamoto Castle up close here.

You can find nice souvenirs and restaurants here. There's tourist information center.

A whole view of Kumamoto Castle can be seen from the 14th floor. It opens also on weekends and holidays (free of charge).

This is a traditional Japanese garden. You can enjoy tea at the special room (extra charge).

You might be able to meet Kumamon. Rare Kumamon goods are available.

These are the biggest shopping streets in Kumamoto. There are many famous brand stores and restaurants as well as a department store.

Get off at "Shiritsutaiikukan-mae(City Gymnasium)" tram stop and 15 mins. on foot. (About 30 mins. from downtown area)

JR & Bus

Take JR and get off at JR Tateno Station. Then, change to the local bus and get off at "Shinsai Iko Kyu Tokai Daigaku" bus stop. (About 1 h 50 mins. from Kumamoto City)

Usopp

Place : JR Aso Station in Aso City

Get off at JR Aso Station. (About 2 h from Kumamoto City)

Bus

Take Yamabiko Bus or Kyushu Odan Bus and get off at "Aso Eki Mae(Aso Station)" bus stop. (About 2 h from Kumamoto City)

Franky

Place : Takamori Station(Minamiaso Railway) in Takamori Town

JR

Take JR to JR Tateno Station and change to the local bus. Then, get off at Takamori Station. (About 2 h from Kumamoto City)

Bus

Take Takamori Bus or Takachiho Bus and get off at "Takamori Chuo" bus stop. Then 5 mins. on foot. (About 1 h 50 mins. from Kumamoto City)

- Select Wi-Fi
- Open Browser
- User Registration

1. Select your language, review the terms of service, and click "Access the internet here."
2. Choose the method of registration (e-mail address or social media account)
3. Input the necessary information, agree to the terms of service, and click "continue."
4. Review the security information and click "confirm."

Registration by e-mail
5. Open the registration confirmation e-mail and click the URL to connect to Wi-Fi.

Registration by social media
5. Connect to Wi-Fi by logging into the social media account. (Example using Facebook below.)

*You will be disconnected after three hours. However, there is no limit to the number of times you can connect.

1. Choose the method of registration (e-mail address or social media account)

Registration by e-mail
2. Mail authentication system. The mail address which can be received at the place is input, and (transmission) is chosen.
3. 4 digits of password which is indicated on a received mail is input to password entry field. Selective registry completes (transmission), and it can be connected now to the internet.

Registration by social media
2. SNS which chooses and uses "SNS Account authentication system" is chosen. I log in to SNS with directions of a screen.
3. Registration is completed and it can be connected now to the internet.


*As a Guest Account, you can use Wi-Fi without user registration. It is available for ten minutes every three hours.


Aso Shrine




Daikanbo
